

## Investments in ITC projects under implementation exceed OMR4.3bn

The total investment in projects related to integrated tourism complexes (ITCs) under implementation is estimated at OMR4.376 billion in addition to OMR3.120 billion in other licenced projects which are in the pre-implementation phase. The Ministry of Heritage and Tourism has also granted 19 valid licences for integrated tourism complexes, including a number of projects across the governorates of Muscat, Dhofar, Al Sharqiyah South, Al Batinah South, and Musandam. These projects number 81 hotel facilities, with 16,576 hotel rooms, 2,552 apartment hotels and villas and 42,617 housing units, in addition to golf courses and a number of harbours, restaurants, cafes and shops.

## Oman airports see over 80% surge in traffic

The total number of passengers travelling through airports of the Sultanate of Oman until the end of April 2023 grew by 81% to reach 4,209,846 as against 2,324,007 passengers during the corresponding period in 2022, according to the latest reported preliminary data released by the National Centre for Statistics and information (NCSI). The total number of passengers via Muscat International Airport stood at 3,792,212 at the end of April 2023 compared to 1,984,428 passengers at the end of April 2022, marking a rise of 91.1%.

## **HM The Sultan issues Royal Decree establishing Khazaen Economic City**

His Majesty Sultan Haitham bin Tarik on Monday issued a Royal decree, reading as follows:

Royal Decree No. 44/2023 establishes Khazaen Economic City and promulgates its Bylaw (articles of association). Article (1) stipulates that an economic city shall be set up in the governorate of South Al Batinah, to be named "Khazaen Economic City" and to be established on the land area demarcated in accordance with the layout attached to this decree. The city shall be under the supervision of the Public Authority for Special Economic Zones and Free Zones and it shall be governed by the attached Bylaw.
